### Program highlights

- Attend classes on Zoom two days per week, plus attend optional in-person classes on Fridays at Hopelink Redmond, Hopelink Shoreline, or Rainier Beach Branch, The Seattle Public Library.
- Hopelink computers are available to borrow if needed.
- Receive one-on-one career advising.
- Participate in practice job interviews with local employers.
- Complete the program within three months.

Morning and evening class options are available. Classes are best for students with intermediate and advanced level English skills.
